Dynamic Contrast Matching	Dynamic Contrast Matching technology uses the printer profile itself to match your image settings to the dynamic range of the paper you've selected. DCM is built into every ImagePrint profile working behind the scenes to deliver perfect tonality on the very first print.	All the time. (Unless you <i>like</i> readjusting your images every time you change papers.)
Our Profile Library	Over 25,000 state-of-the-art profiles available right now. Color profiles built for 5 different lighting temperatures and grayscale profiles that have set the industry standard. ICC Compliant	ImagePrint is an ICC color managed application and can use any ICC color profile.	To use your own custom-made profiles without losing any of the other benefits ImagePrint has to offer. (Recommended only if you actually enjoy building profiles. Remember, ImagePrint comes with a vast library of top-of-the-line profiles ready for use right out of the box.)
Dynamic Layout Features	You can easily place, crop, size or dress-up images visually. All in a non-destructive way.	To size and crop on the fly without making changes to the original file.
Vector Text Capabilities	Custom text can be added anywhere on the page or image without having to create a new image just for printing.	To create photographic products that include decorative text.
Backgrounds and Borders	Add borders, frames, backgrounds and mattes to your images. You can even adjust the transparency of each element. The changes you make are non-destructive, so your original file is undisturbed.	To create greeting cards, album pages, or to personalize any photo.
B/W Dark Room Effects	ImagePrint duplicates traditional dark room techniques like Selenium and Sepia toning on warm, cool and neutral papers. Boundary Creation	You can define areas for creating cards or album pages that can be easily cut from a larger piece of paper. Photo Packaging	Build templates with pre-defined sizes and styles then drag and drop images onto the template.	To make single or multi-image photo packages - - automatically.

Job Archiving	Save images, job data, and profiles into an archive that can be stored and retrieved for future reprints	To archive single or multiple jobs for backup and historical printing.

AutoPrint Hot Folders	By-pass the ImagePrint interface and save images directly to a folder for automated printing using your customized settings.	To create a fully-automated "hands free" workflow.
Queue Manager	Let's you monitor, edit, reprint and cancel print jobs. You can even control print jobs running on multiple computers and multiple printers.	To take full control over all of your print jobs.
Rebuild Layouts	Recalls a previously printed job into the ImagePrint interface for editing.	To make small or large changes to already printed jobs before reprinting them.
PTAP (Optional)	PTAP lets you print from any other application right to the ImagePrint driver.	To print directly from another application with all the benefits of ImagePrint's color management system.
Free Email Support	Free email support is included for the life of each version, or one year from date of purchase, whichever is longer.	To get a little help using a feature, reinstalling the software, or locating a profile.
